FMI- The Food Industry Association would like to invite you to a tour of UNFI's Harrisburg Distribution Center on **Wednesday, June 28th, 2023**. The purpose of this trip to the United Natural Foods, Inc. (UNFI) Harrisburg Distribution Center is to provide congressional staff with a firsthand understanding of food safety practices and the food supply chain. Participants will tour the facility with food safety professionals, learn about current technologies available, and see the processes and procedures necessary for a supply chain to function safely and effectively.

The Harrisburg Distribution Center is approximately 2.5 hours driving from Washington DC. FMI will provide transportation to and from the facility via chartered vans leaving from the Capitol Hill area. Per Senate Ethics Committee Rules, you must go through the appropriate process to partake in transportation provided by FMI.

If you do not wish to partake in the provided transportation or miss the deadline to submit paperwork to the Ethics Committee, we still welcome your participation on the tour of the facility if you drive yourself.

If you choose to partake in the provided transportation, you will need to submit your traveler package to Ethics through the Senate Committee on Ethics Privately Sponsored Travel Portal by **Monday, May 29th** at the latest due to the requirement that the committee be notified 30 days prior to the departure date. Please note that Monday is Memorial Day, so we recommend getting the forms in as soon as possible.
