





The immersive experience is designed to foster deep discussion on Arctic security, transatlantic defense cooperation, and the cultural and spiritual foundations of Western values within the European Union. Set against the backdrop of Nordic cultural security landscapes of significance, the program will strengthen relationships, sharpen geopolitical insight, and reinforce a shared commitment to liberty and sovereignty across the Atlantic.

This transatlantic study tour brings U.S. Senate staff into direct engagement with EU policy leaders and scholars to assess the evolving security landscape in the Nordic region and its implications for transatlantic cooperation. With the Stoltenberg Report as a central point of reference, the program addresses urgent questions around Nordic defense integration, Arctic preparedness, and the future of NATO in an era of renewed competition. The itinerary includes key Cold War strategic sites in Norway and across the Nordic region—locations once at the front line of Soviet deterrence—which are now returning to relevance as tensions escalate on Europe's eastern flank. By investing in the strategic education of senior U.S. policy influencers, TP Action is helping to build a future-facing leadership cohort equipped to navigate the Nordic-American relationship and uphold the transatlantic order under renewed pressure.


